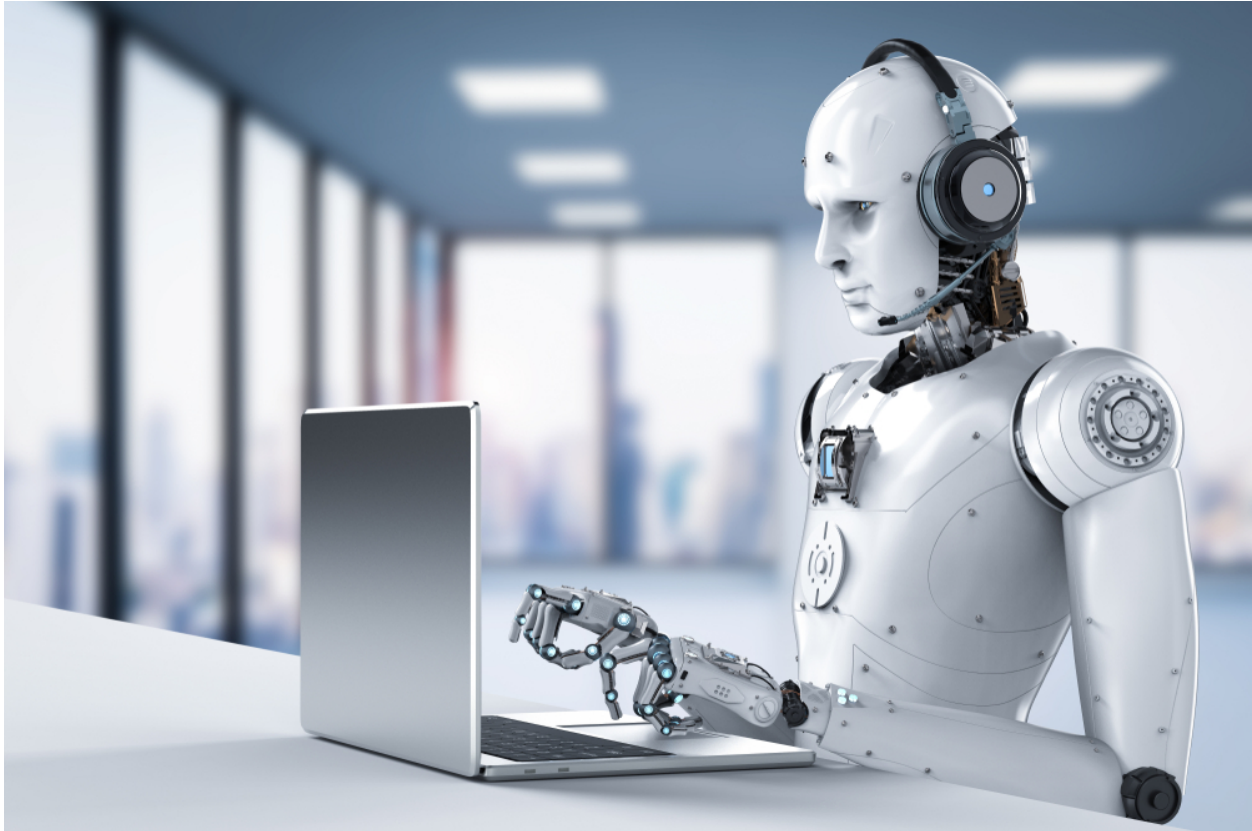


## What's the latest way to get the best DMV appointment?
